3. Regularly review the residual risks faced as a result of their operations and the external environment in which they operate in.
4. Apply robust risk management processes as an integral element of the planning and performance of the management system.
5. Ensure that the key principals of risk management are adhered to by all staff and volunteers by regularly observing them working with groups.
