- 2. Regularly review their clients, staff and volunteers exposure to all forms of risk and reduce it as far as reasonably practicable or achievable.
- 3. Regularly review the residual risks faced as a result of their operations and the external environment in which they operate in.
- 4. Apply robust risk management processes as an integral element of the planning and performance of the management system.
- 5. Ensure that the key principals of risk management are adhered to by all staff and volunteers by regularly observing them working with groups.
